BANGALORE MORNING INFERENCE DATED: 24.05.2019

- A CYCLONIC CIRCULATION LIES OVER SOUTH INTERIOR KARNATAKA & NEIGHBOURHOOD AND EXTENDS UPTO 0.9 KM ABOVE MEAN SEA LEVEL.
- A TROUGH RUNS FROM THE ABOVE CYCLONIC CIRCULATION TO SOUTH TAMILNADU ACROSS INTERIOR TAMILNADU AT 0.9 KM ABOVE MEAN SEA LEVEL.
- THE TROUGH AT 0.9 KM ABOVE MEAN SEA LEVEL FROM EAST MADHYA PRADESH TO NORTH COASTAL KARNATAKA ACROSS VIDARBHA, MARATHWADA AND SOUTH MADHYA MAHARASHTRA HAS BECOME LESS MARKED.
- THE TROUGH FROM NORTH INTERIOR KARNATAKA TO COMORIN AREA ACROSS SOUTH INTERIOR KARNATAKA AND INTERIOR TAMILNADU AT 1.5 KM ABOVE MEAN SEA LEVEL HAS BECOME LESS MARKED.
- KALABURGI REORDED HIGHEST MAXIMUM TEMPERATURE OF 44.2 DEC C IN THE PLAINS OF THE STATE.
